

Hello Excellent Humans!!

It's your Firefly Parking Co-Leads, Narwhal and FLY!

We're super grateful that you have chosen to be a parking volunteer! Parking is a very important role at Firefly because if we can't deal with all the vehicles, there's no way we can have an event. Parking is a big core, with over 130 volunteers (only Rangers have more), so in a real sense you are the initial face of Firefly for participants.

Here's what we would like you to do now:

- 1) Confirm your volunteer shift(s) on the [Volunteer Portal](#)
- 2) WRITE DOWN the date and time of your shift somewhere – don't rely on your phone
- 3) Reply to this email if you have any questions or concerns

When it's time for your shift, please do the following:

- 1) Arrive 10 minutes early at the location you will be volunteering (LOWER, UPPER NEXUS, or MAIN PARKING – see the Firefly map)
- 2) Bring everything you might need to stay comfortable and effective (hat, weather appropriate clothing, robust footwear, snacks, water, sunscreen, bug spray, can-do attitude, etc). Sunset is at about 8:30 PM so if your shift goes later, bring a flashlight.

We've got some FAQs for you too:

What are my specific responsibilities?

They're slightly different at each lot – you'll find detailed instructions when you arrive for your shift – but basically we are facilitating getting cars to their resting places quickly and efficiently, and then getting them out onto the road the same way.

What if I forget when my shift is?

You can check all the volunteer shifts at GNOMES, or at UPPER NEXUS.

What if I can't make my shift?

Try *really really hard* to make it, because if there is a sudden gap, volunteers from the previous shift can wind up pulling extra long shifts. But we know that sh*t happens; if it happens to you, call the Parking Leads (that's us!) on the radio to let us know (find someone with a radio and ask them to call us on Channel 5). If you're not onsite yet you can try emailing us (parking@fireflyartscollective.org) but that's a long shot after tomorrow. The earlier we know, the more elegantly we can fill the gap. If you miss a shift, don't worry, we will find another volunteer opportunity for you.
